

The Epistle of St James

 - * H e was the head of the first church Council in


Jerusalem at 50AD.


- * The Jews threw him from the highest point of the Jewish temple and when he fell they hit him on his head and he was martyred.

- > **The idea:** we are justified by both faith and doing also he gives us practical advice to keep our own tongue from sinning. He talks about the true Christianity.


